

Updated Statewide Guidelines Pertaining to Golf Facilities in Massachusetts

The Massachusetts Golf Association (MGA) and Alliance of Massachusetts Golf Organizations (AMGO) announced the following to all courses in Massachusetts today.

The Governor and his Administration will be making two important updates to the golf specific guidance inclusive of the allowance of Double Rider carts for all golfers and the option for Removal of Flagsticks with Hole Liners no longer being required effective Monday, 5 October 2020. These allowances will be statewide and not specific to lower risk communities.

The Country Club of Wilbraham and staff, ask all Members and players to consider sharing carts, if you are comfortable and feel safe, as our carts have taken a real beating this season and the down time will allow our staff to make some essential repairs and perform much needed maintenance. Our priority is your safety and our staff will accommodate your requests and needs without reservation.

DOUBLE RIDER CARTS

Double rider golf carts will be permitted beginning Monday, October 5, 2020. Once the exact guidance and language is updated on the [Mass.gov](https://www.mass.gov) website we will be sure to share that with all Member Club Contacts so that appropriate preparations may be made.

FLAGSTICKS

Hole liners will no longer be required and golfers may choose to remove the flagstick from the hole.
